<sup>1</sup> Apartment project scope covers 1–4 residential dwelling units whose owners do not control the entire building.

<sup>2</sup> Projects installing equipment to provide domestic hot water heating, either a HPWH or as part of a system that supports space and water heating, as in a water-to-water heat pump associated with a GSHP system or certain air-to-water configurations.

<sup>3</sup> Category 5b are installed as integrated components in an eligible GSHP: Residential Full Load Heating project as defined in the program manual.

## Here's how to apply for Clean Heat incentives:

- Enroll as a participating contractor at [nystatewidecmp.customerapplication.com](https://nystatewidecmp.customerapplication.com).
- Receive a list of eligible equipment and a buying guide to help you explain the benefits of eligible equipment to customers.
- Purchase and install qualified equipment for a residential National Grid electric customer.
- Submit projects on the NYS Clean Heat program [online intake portal](#).

## Incentive amounts

There are four incentive rates offered for each space heating category, differentiated by projects in single-family homes and apartments and by location in or outside a Disadvantaged Community (DAC). These are summarized in the utility incentive tables in the [New York State Clean Heat program manual](#).

Projects in DACs are eligible to receive incentives that cover up to 85% of project costs, while incentives for projects outside of DACs are capped at 70% of project costs. Contractors can determine whether a project is in a DAC by searching the address at: [nyscrda.ny.gov/ny/Disadvantaged-Communities](https://nyscrda.ny.gov/ny/Disadvantaged-Communities)

The NYS Clean Heat program offers two categories of water heating incentives: Category 5 – Downstream Domestic Water Heating and Category 5b – GSHP Desuperheater.

## Additional eligibility notes

Refer to the NEEP list to ensure air-source heat pump equipment eligibility.

Geothermal heat pumps must meet or exceed the ENERGY STAR® geothermal heat pump specification.

Heat pump water heaters must meet or exceed ENERGY STAR Residential Water Heater specification.

Refer to the [NYS Clean Heat Qualifying Product List](#) to confirm air-to-water heat pump eligibility.

Total heat pump system heating capacity must satisfy at least 100%–120% of the BHL at design conditions.

New construction is not eligible to receive incentives for ASHP or AWHP for space heating. New construction is only eligible to receive incentives for GSHP for space heating, GSHP paired with other custom water solutions, heat pump-based solutions for domestic hot water usage, or HPWH incentives.

For decommissioning applications, eligible projects must include heat pumps that meet the full building load where the previously existing fossil fuel system is decommissioned.
